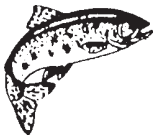


# 2011 TROUT ORDER FORM

## Attention Pond Owners!

### Do You Have a Pond Stocking License??

If you're thinking about stocking your pond in the near future, you should be aware that New York State Fish and Wildlife Law requires that you **first** secure a Farm Fish Pond License before releasing any species of fish.

These licenses are issued free of charge by the NYS DEC in Stamford. Pond owners thinking about taking advantage of our Trout Stocking Program this October 1, 2011 should secure their applications now and have them returned to DEC in Stamford as soon as possible.

## Attention Trout Stockers!

-Stocking Recommendations-

4"-6" Rainbow Trout 150-200 per surface acre  
4"-6" Brook Trout 200-300 per surface acre

\*Generally, the pond should not be shallower than ten (10) feet deep. The water temperature should not go higher than 60-65° at the bottom.

### **Do Not Bring Water With You.**

We have changed the delivery procedures for picking up fish. All fish will be bagged in oxygenated water for traveling convenience. **(Bags \$1.00 each)**

After reaching your pond, place the bag in the pond and leave it until the water temperatures have equalized, then release your fish. This will help the fish to acclimate to the pond water with less chance of temperature shock.

The pick-up date will be SATURDAY, OCTOBER 1, 2011 at **10:00 A.M. SHARP**, in the **SWCD Parking Lot at 44 West Street in Walton.**
